MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL  
NOVEMBER 6, 2000

The City Council of Red Bay met in a regular meeting November 6, 2000, at 7:00 P.M.

Present and presiding was Mayor Tommy G. Nelson and Council members present: Peggy Cox, Johnny Cleveland, Jimmy Mayfield, Lowell Gober, and Eucellis Underwood.

Shirley J. Cody, City Clerk, was present and recording.

Eucellis Underwood led the Invocation.

Peggy Cox led the Allegiance to the Flag.

Others present were City Inspector Bob Hardin, Animal Control Officer Randoll Belue, Jeff Sartain, and Tammy Underwood.

Jeff Sartain asked permission to have a wrestling show at the Red Bay High School gymnasium. Sartain said 30% of the admission would be given to the school and all the money from concession. The mayor and council recommended he speak with the principal of the school.

A new business, Rydin Decal, is going to locate in Red Bay on Highway #11. The business is hoping to be operating by next spring.

The City Municipal Court took in \$65,161.84 the last fiscal year.

Tammy Underwood recommended the Founders Fest Committee be Reb Boatwright, Lisa Stockton, and herself, Chairperson, for the next year. Lowell Gober made a motion to accept

the recommendation of Tammy Underwood, seconded by Peggy Cox. Unanimously passed.

Jimmy Mayfield made a motion to annex 80 acres into the city limits that lays northeast of Red Bay donated by Johnny Mack Morrow for a wildlife sanctuary, seconded by Lowell Gober. Unanimously passed.

Johnny Cleveland made a motion to hire another mechanic, seconded by Lowell Gober. Unanimously passed.

Johnny Cleveland made a motion to hire Wayne Brand as a mechanic, seconded by Jimmy Mayfield. Unanimously passed.

Lowell Gober made a motion to pay due bills, seconded by Johnny Cleveland. Unanimously passed.

Peggy Cox made a motion to approve previous minutes of October 16, 2000, seconded by Jimmy Mayfield. Unanimously passed.

Eucellis Underwood made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Lowell Gober. Unanimously passed.
