MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL
DECEMBER 4, 2000

The City Council of Red Bay met in a regular meeting December 4, 2000, at 7:00 P.M.

Present and presiding was Mayor Tommy G. Nelson and Council Members present: Peggy Cox, Johnny Cleveland, Jimmy Mayfield, Lowell Gober, and Eucellis Underwood.

Shirley J. Cody, City Clerk, was present and recording.

Johnny Cleveland led the Invocation.

Jimmy Mayfield led the Allegiance to the Flag.

Lowell Gober made a motion to accept Sherri Hubbard's resignation, seconded by Peggy Cox. Unanimously passed.

Johnny Cleveland made a motion that with the chief and seven police officers working 43 hours per week, two men per shift leaving 35 hours for one man, to let the force stay as is, seconded by Lowell Gober. Unanimously passed.

Eucellis Underwood made a motion to pay Benjamin Raburn, Police Officer, top out pay @\$11.02 per hour, seconded by Johnny Cleveland. Unanimously passed.

Lowell Gober made a motion to table the Park & Recreation Rules until next meeting, seconded by Eucellis Underwood. Unanimously passed.

Two men with the street department, one clerical part-time worker, and no replacement on the police department, were laid-off due to no work.




Jimmy Mayfield made a motion to pay due bills, seconded by Lowell Gober. Unanimously passed.

STREET AND SANITATION DEPARTMENT
SAFETY PROGRAM

UNDER THE NEW WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION COMPANY POLICY, EACH CITY OR MUNICIPALITY MUST HAVE AN APPOINTED SAFETY COORDINATOR AND A WRITTEN SAFETY PROGRAM. DUE TO THIS REQUIREMENT, STREET SUPERINTENDENT, TOMMY NELSON IS THE SAFETY COORDINATOR FOR THIS DEPARTMENT AND THE FOLLOWING IS THE SAFETY PROGRAM/RULES.

1. Each truck driver must have a valid drivers license.
2. Each driver on any vehicle must check tires, lights, and brakes before operating vehicle.
3. If your license requires or has restrictions, such as glasses, etc., these must be in use when operating any city vehicle.
4. Keep all work areas marked with proper caution signs.
5. Be sure no one is close to you when operating lawn mower.
6. When using cutting equipment such as, chain saws, weed eaters, etc., make sure no one is within 30 feet of the work area.
7. Employees must wear gloves when working in sewer, with brush or limbs, and garbage.
8. Wear safety glasses when welding, grinding, operating city vehicles, using hammers, or riding the garbage trucks.
9. No smoking in the vicinity of sewer or open manholes.
10. Never ride on the fenders or running boards of city vehicles.
11. No one is allowed on dozier or backhoe except person operating machine.

12. Must wear high-top boots with at least a 1/2" heel when working.
13. Obey all traffic signs when operating city vehicles.
14. Shirttail, coattail, and sleeves must be closed when operating city equipment.
15. Stay away from back of backhoe when it is in operation.
16. When flagging or directing traffic, be courteous, but do not engage in conversation, be alert at all times.
17. Keep all correct warning signs in place when using equipment on or near street or highway.
18. Be sure that safety chains are properly working and on bushhog at all times.
19. Be sure that caution lights are working on bushhog and garbage trucks at all times.
20. Be sure that all vehicles have come to a complete stop before dismounting.
21. No smoking on garbage trucks or brush trucks.
