MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL
FEBRUARY 19, 2001

The City Council of Red Bay met in a regular meeting February 19, 2001, at 7:00 p.m.

Present and presiding was Tommy G. Nelson and Council Members present: Peggy Cox, Johnny Cleveland, Jimmy Mayfield, Lowell Gober, and Eucellis Underwood.

Tracie Bolding, City Secretary, was present and recording.

Johnny Cleveland led the Invocation.

Tommy Nelson led the Allegiance to the Flag..

Others present were Police Chief "Reb" Boatwright, City Inspector Bob Hardin, representative of the Franklin County Times and the Red Bay News.

The Mayor ask that a statement about Red Bay clean up ordinance be placed in the Red Bay News, letting citizen know that if there is a complaint about someone property action will be taken.

The Mayor and Council signed Ordinance # 001-02-05 for AirEVac, that was passed at the February 5, 2001 meeting.
