MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL
MARCH 5, 2001

The City Council of Red Bay met in a regular meeting **March 5, 2001** at 7:00p.m.

Present and presiding was Mayor Tommy G. Nelson and Council members present: Peggy Cox, Johnny Cleveland, Jimmy Mayfield, Lowell Gober and Eucellis Underwood.

Tracie Bolding, City Secretary, was present and recording.

Eucellis Underwood led the invocation.

Jimmy Mayfield led the allegiance to the Flag.

Others present were Police Chief "Reb" Boatwright, City Inspector Bob Hardin, Coye Marbutt owner of Parkview Trailer Park and Mini Storage, James Woodall and Brente Jefferies with the Relay for the American Cancer Society and City Attorneys Jeff Bowling and John McRenolds.

Brente Jefferies and James Woodall addressed the council asking to set up a road block for the Relay for Life for the American Cancer Society. Jimmy Mayfield made a motion to allow the road block on Saturday March 17th from 9 to 12 at the intersection of Golden Road and Hwy. 24. Lowell Gober seconded. Unanimously passed.

The City's Audit has been completed by Dicky H. Sparks CPA firm. Lowell Gober made a motion to accept and approve the audit for fiscal year September 30, 2000. Peggy Cox seconded. Unanimously passed.

The Mayor informed the council that the City did not receive the T.E. Grant for the walking trail.

The Mayor presented a letter that he would like to have approved for all police officers. "No Police Officers can be in the City Hall unless they are on break or have been called by the dispatcher." Lowell Gober made a motion to approve the letter. Johnny Cleveland seconded. Unanimously passed.

Peggy Cox made a motion to go into executive session. Johnny Cleveland seconded. Unanimously passed.

The council went into executive session. After returning Jimmy Mayfield made a motion to go back into regular session of the council meeting. Eucellis Underwood seconded. Unanimously passed.

City Attorney Jeff Bowling spoke and said no motions were made during the executive session.

Johnny Cleveland made a motion to place a Police Officer on suspension without pay for 30 days. Peggy Cox seconded. Unanimously passed.

The Mayor received a letter form ADEM saying the inspection of the City Land field had been completed and that the City had no violations.

The Mayor extended the bid opening on the Pathfinder till March 19, 2001 due to not having the ad in the paper 3 weeks.

Coye Marbut addressed the council about having the circle in Parkview Trailer Park and Mini Storage turned into a City Street.. Jimmy Mayfield made a motion for the City to accept the land if it is deeded over to the City. The land should have a 50ft. Right of way, and will only be a one way street named Parkview Circle. The street will be taken in, as is, per the City Ordinance. Eucellis Underwood seconded. Unanimously passed.

Johnny Cleveland made a motion to pay due bills. Lowell Gober seconded. Unanimously passed with the exception of Eucellis Underwood abstaining from the True Value Hardware bill.

Peggy Cox made a motion to approve the minutes from the regular meeting of February 19, 2001. Jimmy Mayfield seconded. Unanimously passed.

Eucellis Underwood made a motion to adjourn.
