MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL
SEPTEMBER 4, 2001

The City Council of Red Bay met in a regular meeting September 4, 2001 at 6:05 p.m.

Present and presiding was Mayor Tommy G. Nelson and Council Members present: Peggy Cox, Johnny Cleveland, Lowell Gober, and Eucellis Underwood. Council Member Jimmy Mayfield was absent.

Peggy Cox made a motion to appoint George Shaw on the Industrial Board, as an aeronautical representative, seconded by Lowell Gober. Unanimously passed.

Roger Bedford requested \$25,000 state money for a Sports Complex and Police Department. This money is to be used at Dixie Youth, Family Fun Park, and Police Department.

Lowell Gober made a motion to approve an ad on WRMG Broadcast in the amount of \$550.00 with Water & Gas paying one-half and the city one-half, seconded by Johnny Cleveland. Unanimously passed.

Lowell Gober made a motion to hire Cully J. Cody as dispatcher, seconded by Peggy Cox. Unanimously passed.

Lowell Gober made a motion to buy a 1996 one-ton Ford truck with bed, 4 wheel drive to be used by the Sewer Department for \$4500.00, seconded by Eucellis Underwood. Unanimously passed.

Lowell Gober made a motion to pay due bills, seconded by Johnny Cleveland. All voted FOR except Eucellis Underwood on Underwood True Value, he ABSTAINED.

Peggy Cox made a motion to approve previous minutes, seconded by Lowell Gober. Unanimously passed.

Eucellis Underwood made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Lowell Gober. Unanimously passed.
