MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL  
NOVEMBER 19, 2001

The City Council of Red Bay met in a regular meeting November 19, 2001, at 7:00 p.m.

Present and presiding was Mayor Tommy G. Nelson and Council Members present were Peggy Cox, Jimmy Mayfield, Lowell Gober, and Eucellis Underwood. Johnny Cleveland arrived at 7:05 p.m.

Shirley J. Cody, City Clerk, was present and recording.

Jimmy Mayfield led the Invocation.

Peggy Cox led the Allegiance to the Flag.

Others present were City Inspector Bob Hardin and Officer Josh Garrison, who graduated from the Police Academy on November 14, 2001.

Mayor Nelson reported that two houses in Red Bay has been condemned - one on 10th Street NE and Intersection 24, one on Golden Road across from Oh Bryan Steak House.

A letter was received from Quinn Ranch thanking the city for their support and contribution.

Notification was received that V.F. Jeanswear (Blue Bell) will close January 13, 2002. They employ approximately two hundred seventy three.

Lowell Gober made a motion to accept the decision of the City of Red Bay Planning Commission to rezone the Brown property that is located between Highway 24 and Sunshine Homes from R-2 to M-2, seconded by Johnny Cleveland. Unanimously passed.

A Memorandum on General Obligation Warrants is scheduled for tomorrow.

Jimmy Mayfield made a motion to pay \$50.00 Associate Dues for George Shaw to The Aviation Council of Alabama, Inc., Montgomery, Al., seconded by Peggy Cox. Unanimously passed.

Peggy Cox made a motion to advertize for sell a 1996 Lumina Chevrolet police car and reserve the right to accept or refuse any bid. Bid must be turned in by December 17, 2001, at 4:00 p.m. The motion was seconded by Lowell Gober. Unanimously passed.

Lowell Gober made a motion to pay due bills, seconded by Johnny Cleveland. Unanimously passed.

Peggy Cox made a motion to approve previous minutes of November 5, 2001, seconded by Johnny Cleveland. Unanimously passed.

Eucellis Underwood made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Lowell Gober. Unanimously passed.
