MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL
DECEMBER 17, 2001

The City Council of Red Bay met in a regular meeting December 17, 2001 at 7:00 p.m.

Present and presiding was Mayor Tommy G. Nelson and Council Members present were Peggy Cox, Johnny Cleveland, Jimmy Mayfield, Lowell Gober, and Eucellis Underwood.

Shirley J. Cody, City Clerk, was present and recording.

Matthew Senkbeil led the Invocation.

Jimmy Mayfield led the Allegiance to the Flag.

Lowell Gober made a motion to pay due bills, seconded by Johnny Cleveland. All voted FOR except on Underwood True Value, Eucellis Underwood ABSTAINED.

Peggy Cox made a motion to approve previous minutes of December 3, 2001, seconded by Jimmy Mayfield. Unanimously passed.

Eucellis Underwood made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Lowell Gober. Unanimously passed.
