MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL
APRIL 15, 2002

The City Council of Red Bay met in a regular meeting April 15, 2002, at 7:00 p.m.

Present and presiding was Mayor Tommy G. Nelson and Council Members present were Peggy Cox, Johnny Cleveland, Jimmy Mayfield, Lowell Gober, and Eucellis Underwood.

Shirley J. Cody, City Clerk, was present and recording.

Eucellis Underwood led the Invocation.

Shirley J. Cody led the Allegiance to the Flag.

Others present were City Inspector Bob Hardin, Kenneth Brooks, NACOLG Community Development Sewer Service 2002 Competitive CDBG Application review. Absent were Police Chief "Reb" Boatwright and Fire Chief Bud Strickland.

Charlie Brown and Mike Sewell met concerning the zoning of the Brown property. The Planning Commission met April 5, 2002, to rezone property west of town left side of Highway 24 to light industrial and commercial and also right side Highway 24 NW side to light industrial and commercial. Johnny Cleveland made a motion to accept the decision of the Planning Board seconded by Lowell Gober. Unanimously passed.

Two bids were submitted for roofing the City Park building:

D & D Mobile Home & Residential	- \$3517.35

Lowell Gober made a motion to accept the low bid from Earl Pendergraph in the amount of \$1613.15, seconded by Jimmy Mayfield. Unanimously passed.

Peggy Cox made a motion for free garbage pick-up week be the 2nd week of May, one call,

one load per resident, no air conditioners with freon, refrigerator or freezer with freon, seconded by Lowell Gober. Unanimously passed.

Johnny Cleveland made a motion to turn over to the City Attorney if a permit can be issued for a KKK Rally out of Mississippi to march in Red Bay, seconded by Lowell Gober. Unanimously passed.

Kenneth Brooks presented the 2002 competitive CDBG Application for the City of Red Bay Sanitary Sewer Project Cost Summary as follows:

Lowell Gober made a motion to authorize Mayor Nelson and Clerk Shirley J. Cody to sign all applications and Resolution #02-04-15, #02-14-15A, seconded by Eucellis Underwood. Unanimously passed.

The Sewage Board met and agreed to pay \$25,000.00 on new sewer project and borrow \$49,000.00 against a \$52,000.00 CD for our portion of local cash. Lowell Gober made a motion to accept the decision of the Sewage Board, seconded by Jimmy Mayfield. Unanimously passed.

Peggy Cox made a motion to reappoint the following to the Red Bay Education Committee:

Seconded by Johnny Cleveland. Unanimously passed.

Johnny Cleveland made a motion to pay \$500.00 for a rebuilt part to the scales that was hit by lightning rather than to pay \$1,000.00 for old unit to be fixed, seconded by Jimmy Mayfield. Unanimously passed.

Lowell Gober made a motion to sign Resolution #02-04-15B to support the expedite construction and completion of Corridor V from Mouton to Red Bay to the intersection with Corridor X near Fulton, Ms., seconded by Peggy Cox. Unanimously passed.

Jimmy Mayfield made a motion to donate \$200.00 to Relay For Life Cancer Drive with Water & Gas paying ½ of cost in Lieu of Taxes, seconded by Johnny Cleveland. Unanimously passed.

The Red Bay Police Department road block for Walk America March of Dimes was successful in the amount of f\$1,104.00.

Johnny Cleveland made a motion to appoint Johnny Hargett on the Sewage Board to replace Kenneth Shotts, seconded by Jimmy Mayfield. Unanimously passed.

Lowell Gober made a motion to donate \$200.00 to Ruth's Ministry for a Ladies Conference with Water & Gas paying ½ cost in Lieu of Taxes, seconded by Jimmy Mayfield. Unanimously passed.

Johnny Cleveland made a motion to pay due bills, seconded by Lowell Gober. All voted FOR except on Underwood True value Hardware, Eucellis Underwood ABSTAINED.

Peggy Cox made a motion to approve previous minutes of April 1, 2002, seconded by Jimmy Mayfield. Unanimously passed.

Eucellis Underwood made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Lowell Gober. Unanimously passed.
