MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL
MAY 6, 2002

The City Council of Red Bay met in a regular meeting May 6, 2002, at 7:00 p.m.

Present and presiding was Mayor Tommy G. Nelson and Council Members present were Peggy Cox, Jimmy Mayfield, Lowell Gober and Eucellis Underwood. Johnny Cleveland was present arriving at 7:08 p.m.

Shirley J. Cody, City Clerk, was present and recording.

Brother Larry Hill led the Invocation.

Glen Vinson led the Allegiance to the Flag.

Others present were Police Chief "Reb" Boatwright, City Inspector Bob Hardin. Absent was Fire Chief Bud Strickland.

An application on Stephen Eugene Nix for a Volunteer Fireman was presented but due to present address, Jimmy Mayfield made a motion not to accept because he doesn't live close enough to call in case of fire. Lowell Gober seconded the motion. Unanimously passed.

Glen Vinson, who took George Shaw's position on the Franklin County Economic Development Authority, met to discuss with the council their April 24th meeting.

Brother Larry Hill requested the closing of 110 feet off street 8th Ave SE or Collum Street which adjoins his property. Jimmy Mayfield made a motion to accept the request, seconded by Lowell Gober. Unanimously passed.

Peggy Cox made a motion Little League Board term goes from July to July with

appointments each August, seconded by Johnny Cleveland. Unanimously passed.

Peggy Cox nominated Lowell Baggett to the Cemetery Board. No other nomination was made. Lowell Gober made a motion to close the nomination. All voted FOR appointment of Lowell Baggett.

Johnny Cleveland made a motion for Gene Horton to paint the flag pole for \$100.00 and put a gold ball on top, seconded by Lowell Gober. Unanimously passed.

Lowell Gober made a motion to approve the Planning Commission's decision on rezoning the Brown Property on South East Corner and East Side of Highway 24 to be eligible for a mini-mart, seconded by Johnny Cleveland. Unanimously passed.

Mayor Nelson reported the Fire Department received a \$10,000.00 grant from Roger Bedford.

Peggy Cox made a motion to reappoint Lynette Horton to the Park & Recreation Board, seconded by Jimmy Mayfield. Unanimously passed.

Johnny Cleveland made a motion to pay due bills, seconded by Lowell Gober. Unanimously passed.

Jimmy Mayfield made a motion to approve previous minutes of April 15, 2002, seconded by Peggy Cox. Unanimously passed.

Eucellis Underwood made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Lowell Gober. Unanimously passed.
