MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL
SEPTEMBER 16, 2002

The City Council of Red Bay met in a regular meeting September 16, 2002, at 7:00 p.m

Present and presiding was Mayor Tommy G. Nelson and Council Members present were Peggy Cox, Johnny Cleveland, Jimmy Mayfield, Lowell Gober, and Eucellis Underwood.

Shirley J. Cody, City Clerk, was present and recording.

Johnny Cleveland led the Invocation.

Reb Boatwright led the Allegiance to the Flag.

City Inspector Bob Hardin was present.

Chief "Reb" Boatwright wanted to say, Thank You, to the Mayor and Council for allowing the monument to be placed in Bay Tree Park. A large crowd attended the September 11th program, In Memory of the Fallen Heros of September 11, 2001.

Money from the State has been received in the amount of \$6,700.00 for 2 video cameras for the police cars.

Money from the State has been received in the amount of \$18,747.00 to build a helipad at the Red Bay Hospital. The hospital will advertise for bids on construction. Hopefully the bids will be ready by October 7, 2002, so construction can begin.

Jimmy Mayfield made a motion to approve a \$150.00 ad in the school program, seconded by Lowell Gober. Unanimously passed.

Peggy Cox made a motion for immediate consideration for adoption on RESOLUTION #02-09-16, seconded by Lowell Gober. All voted FOR.

Peggy Cox made a motion to adopt RESOLUTION #02-09-16, Resolution Authorizing the Northwest Alabama Council of Local Governments to Administer CDBG Project LR-CM-PF-02-008, seconded by Lowell Gober. Unanimously passed.

The sewer grant, CDBG Project No. LR-CM-PF-02-008, in the amount of \$417,000.00 has been approved. The construction will be let out on bid.

Lowell Gober made a motion to approve due bills, seconded by Jimmy Mayfield.
Unanimously passed.

Peggy Cox made a motion to approve previous minutes, September 3, 2002, seconded by Jimmy Mayfield. Unanimously passed.

Eucellis Underwood made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Lowell Gober. Unanimously passed.
