MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL
DECEMBER 16, 2002

The City Council of Red Bay met in a regular meeting December 16, 2002, at 7:00 p.m.

Present and presiding was Mayor Tommy G. Nelson and Council Members present were Peggy Cox, Johnny Cleveland, Jimmy Mayfield, Lowell Gober, and Eucellis Underwood.

Shirley J. Cody, City Clerk, was present and recording.

Jimmy Mayfield led the Invocation.

Peggy Cox led the Allegiance to the Flag.

Others present were Police Chief "Reb" Boatwright, City Inspector Bob Hardin, and April Bray with the Franklin County Times.

April Bray explained the Progress Addition in the Franklin County Times to be published February 28. Peggy Cox made a motion to buy 1/4 page ad for \$379.00, seconded by Johnny Cleveland. Unanimously passed.

David Markham's letter thanked the City and Fire Department for their support to the Lions Club as they delivered approximately 247 baskets of food to needed families and the clothing of several children.

Helen Nelson sent a Thank You card to the Mayor, Council, and Staff for their help with the driver's class.

Mayor Nelson received a letter from Roger Bedford to Paul Bowlin, Transportation Director, requesting \$100,000.00 for paving to the City of Red Bay. Governor Don Siegelman's office sent a letter on PROJECT NUMBER 03-RT-54-010, HOYT KEETON WALKING TRAIL, Grant amount \$50,000.00 requesting signatures on the subgrant award.

Lowell Gober made a motion to adopt RESOLUTION #02-12-16, Hoyt Keeton Walking Trail ADECA Project Number 03-RT-54-010, seconded by Jimmy Mayfield. Unanimously passed.

Johnny Cleveland made a motion to donate \$200.00 to Big Brother and Big Sister, seconded by Lowell Gober. Unanimously passed.

Lowell Gober made a motion to approve due bills, seconded by Johnny Cleveland. Unanimously passed.

Peggy Cox made a motion to approve previous minutes, December 2, 2002, seconded by Jimmy Mayfield. Unanimously passed.

Peggy Cox suggested to purchase a machine to level ground at the ball park this next year to be paid from Park & Recreation Funds.

Eucellis Underwood made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Lowell Gober. Unanimously passed.
