MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL  
October 2, 2006

The City Council of Red Bay met in a regular meeting on October 2, 2006 at 7:00 p.m. The meeting was held in the Red Bay Senior Citizens Building.

Present and presiding was Mayor Jeff Reid. Council Members present were Bobby Nelson, Rayford Seahorn, Pat Hammock, Ann Wilkins, and Ricky Holland.

Linda B. Holcomb, City Clerk, was present and recording.

Also present was Fire Chief Bud Strickland.

Ricky Holland led the Invocation.

Rayford Seahorn led the Allegiance to the Flag.

Rayford Seahorn made a motion to **suspend the rules to give immediate consideration** to an ordinance **for** or **against** giving the City of Red Bay retirees a 7% raise through the Alabama State Retirement System. Ricky Holland seconded the motion. A roll call vote was as follows: Bobby Nelson "yeas", Rayford Seahorn "yeas", Pat Hammock "yeas", Ann Wilkins "yeas", and Ricky Holland "yeas". Rayford Seahorn made the motion to adopt the ordinance to approve the 7% raise. Ricky Holland seconded the motion. Voting **For** were Pat Hammock, Rayford Seahorn, and Ricky Holland. Ann Wilkins **Abstained**. Bobby Nelson voted **No.** \*

Ricky Holland made a motion for the mayor and city clerk to sign necessary document to purchase the Keeton property that will be used as the new site for city hall. Rayford Seahorn seconded the motion. Voting **For** were Rayford Seahorn, Pat Hammock, Ann Wilkins, and Ricky Holland. Bobby Nelson **Abstained**.

Item #3 on the agenda, Ordinance to stop the monthly 10% transfer of sales tax from the general fund to the equipment fund will be addressed at a later date.

Item #4 on the agenda, wood chipper, was tabled until the need for the chipper could be further investigated.

Rayford Seahorn made a motion to approve the budget request of \$875.00 per quarter for the 06-07 year for the Franklin County Chamber of Commerce. Ricky Holland seconded the motion. Unanimously passed.

Ricky Holland made a motion to approve the striping of Water Plant Road, seconded by Bobby Nelson. Unanimously passed.

Bobby Nelson made a motion to contract with Danny Davis to strip and wax the floors of the senior citizen building at a cost of \$600.00. Rayford Seahorn seconded the motion. Unanimously passed.

Rayford Seahorn made a motion to allow City Clerk Linda Holcomb to attend the 41<sup>st</sup> Annual Municipal Management Training in Birmingham, November 15-17, 2006. Ricky Holland seconded the motion. Voting **For** were Rayford Seahorn, Pat Hammock, Ann Wilkins, and Ricky Holland. Voting **No** was Bobby Nelson.


Mayor Reid made the following announcements:


1. Water Works and Gas Board – Maurice Fikes six-year term expires November 6, 2006.
