MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL  
November 6, 2006

The City Council of Red Bay met in a regular meeting on November 6, 2006 at 7:00 p.m. The meeting was held in the Red Bay Senior Citizens Building.

Present and presiding was Mayor Jeff Reid. Council Members present were Bobby Nelson, Rayford Seahorn, Pat Hammock, Ann Wilkins, and Ricky Holland.

Linda B. Holcomb, City Clerk, was present and recording.

Also present was Fire Chief Bud Strickland and Police Chief Pat Creel.

Ricky Holland led the Invocation.

Pat Hammock led the Allegiance to the Flag.

Police Chief Pat Creel presented a check in the amount of \$2772.00 to the Council. The check represented funds from a drug seizure made by the Red Bay Police Department. The check will be deposited in the Red Bay Police Drug and Equipment Fund.

Rayford Seahorn made a motion to approve all old and new bills, seconded by Ricky Holland. Unanimously passed.

Ricky Holland made a motion to approve the minutes of the meeting held on October 2, 2006. Rayford Seahorn seconded the motion. Unanimously passed.

Rayford Seahorn made a motion to adopt Resolution #06-11-06 a Resolution for Retirees, Act 2006-510. Ricky Holland seconded the motion, unanimously passed. **Resolution #06-11-06 is attached.**

Rayford Seahorn made a motion to accept the sealed bid from Precision Communication for a 911 recorder system in the amount of \$9294.00. Ricky Holland seconded the motion. Unanimously passed. Precision Communication was the only bid received.

Rayford Seahorn made a motion to accept bids to purchase a vehicle for the use of city hall employees. Ricky Holland seconded the motion. Voting **For** were: Rayford Seahorn, Ricky Holland, and Mayor Jeff Reid. Voting **No** were: Bobby Nelson and Pat Hammock. Ann Wilkins **abstained**. Mayor Jeff Reid announced "motion failed".

Rayford Seahorn made a motion to approve Multi-jurisdictional SWAT Team Training in Anniston, AL on the dates of November 13-16, 2006 for Officers Scottie Belue and Scotty Chandler. Ricky Holland seconded the motion. Voting **For** were: Rayford Seahorn, Pat Hammock, Ricky Holland, and Mayor Jeff Reid. Voting **No** were: Bobby Nelson and Ann Wilkins.

Rayford Seahorn made a motion to set a daily food allowance on out of town travel at \$30.00 (thirty dollars) per day. Ricky Holland seconded the motion. Voting **For** were Bobby Nelson, Rayford Seahorn, Pat Hammock, and Ricky Holland. Ann Wilkins **Abstained**.

Ricky Holland made a motion to purchase eight fire suits for the Red Bay Volunteer Fire Department and then purchase one per quarter until the entire fire department has a new suit. Rayford Seahorn seconded the motion, unanimously passed.

Rayford Seahorn made a motion to deny the Alabama Filmmakers Association, Inc. request for a donation. Bobby Nelson seconded the motion. Unanimously passed.

The six-year term of Maurice Fikes expired on November 6, 2006. Applicants signing the list for the new term expiring November 6, 2012 were:

Rayford Seahorn made a motion to appoint Jeff Clark, seconded by Ricky Holland. Voting **For** were Bobby Nelson, Rayford Seahorn, Ricky Holland, and Jeff Reid. Pat Hammock and Ann Wilkins **Abstained**.

Mayor Jeff Reid announced that due to lack of participation there is a possibility of loosing the NACOLG senior citizen funding and the NACOLG transit van that delivers homebound meals. NACOLG will be reviewing the program during January 2007. Mayor Reid encouraged all seniors to participate in the senior program.

Rayford Seahorn made a motion to approve the minutes of the workshop held on October 16, 2006. Bobby Nelson seconded the motion. Unanimously passed.

Pat Hammock made a motion to approve the minutes of the last regular scheduled meeting held October 16, 2006. Rayford Seahorn seconded the motion. Unanimously passed.

Mayor Jeff Reid made the following announcements:



**RESOLUTION #06-11-06**

Section 1.
