

**STATE OF ALABAMA)****FRANKLIN COUNTY )****CITY OF RED BAY****MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL  
January 15, 2007**

The City Council of Red Bay met in a regular meeting on Monday, January 15, 2007 at 7:00 p.m. The meeting was held in the Red Bay Senior Citizens Building.

Present and presiding was Mayor Jeff Reid. Council Members present were Bobby Nelson, Rayford Seahorn, Pat Hammock, Ann Wilkins and Ricky Holland.

Linda B. Holcomb, City Clerk, was present and recording.

Also present were Fire Chief Bud Strickland, Police Chief Pat Creel, City Attorney Brian Hamilton and Franklin County Times Advertising Director Tiffany Cannon.

Rev. Billy Turbyfill of the Northside Missionary Baptist Church led the Invocation.

Red Bay Girl Scout Troop #231 led the Allegiance to the Flag.

Ricky Holland made a motion to purchase 3000 (three thousand) feet of hose for the fire department at a cost of \$1.00 (one dollar) per foot. Rayford Seahorn seconded the motion. Unanimously passed.

Rayford Seahorn made a motion to hire Josh Ridge as a volunteer fireman. The motion was seconded by Ricky Holland. Unanimously passed.

Franklin County Times Advertising Director Tiffany Cannon addressed the Council concerning the purchase of an ad for the February 25, 2007 Progress Edition. Rayford Seahorn made a motion to purchase the one fourth page color ad at a cost of \$282.00 (two hundred eighty-two dollars). The motion was seconded by Pat Hammock. Unanimously passed.

Mayor Reid informed the Council that the sewer machine to be purchased was too heavy to be hauled by a one ton truck. The City already has a one and a half ton truck that can accommodate the sewer machine. The Council had voted to purchase a one ton truck to haul the sewer machine at the December 18, 2006 meeting.

Councilperson Pat Hammock read a request from the Red Bay Youth Basketball League requesting a (\$500.00) five hundred dollar donation. Ricky Holland made a motion to grant the request with the funds to be paid from the Park and Recreation Fund. Pat Hammock seconded the motion. Unanimously passed.


Mayor Jeff Reid made the following announcements:


1. Sealed bids for the construction of the police station will be opened at 2:00 p.m. on January 24, 2007 at the temporary location of the Red Bay City Hall.
