MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL  
March 19, 2007

The City Council of Red Bay met in a regular meeting on Monday, March 19, 2007 at 7:00 p.m. The meeting was held in the Red Bay Senior Citizens Building, 115 5<sup>th</sup> Ave SE, Red Bay, AL 35582.

Present and presiding was Mayor Jeff Reid. Council Members present were Bobby Nelson, Rayford Seahorn, Pat Hammock, Ann Wilkins and Ricky Holland.

Linda B. Holcomb, City Clerk, was present and recording.

Also present were Fire Chief Bud Strickland, Police Chief Pat Creel and Dixie Youth Vice President Ellis Wooten.

S.A.D.D. (Students Against Destructive Decisions) Representatives Pablo Makepeace and Lauren Sella led the Allegiance to the Flag.

Ralph Winchester led the Invocation.

Ellis Wooten addressed the Council with two requests for the Red Bay Dixie Youth:

1. Purchase a pitching machine at a cost of \$3251.00 (three thousand two hundred and fifty-one dollars).
2. Pay for ½ a load of special crushed stone for the end fields at a cost of \$900.00 (nine hundred dollars)

Rayford Seahorn made a motion to use park and recreation funds to purchase the pitching machine and to pay 1/2 of the cost of a load of crushed stone. Bobby Nelson seconded the motion, unanimously passed.

Pat Hammock made a motion to take bids on rewiring the electrical system at Bay Tree Park. Rayford Seahorn seconded the motion, unanimously passed.

Pat Hammock made a motion for the Council to attend the Franklin County Chamber of Commerce Dinner to be held on March 27, 2007. Ricky Holland seconded the motion, unanimously passed.

Rayford Seahorn made a motion for City Clerk Linda Holcomb to attend training at the Alabama League of Municipalities Annual Conference on April 21-24, 2007, seconded by Pat Hammock. Voting **for** were Rayford Seahorn, Pat Hammock, Ann Wilkins, and Ricky Holland. Voting **no** was Bobby Nelson. The motion carried.

Bobby Nelson made a motion for a roadblock to be held on May 5, 2007, proceeds will benefit Kassie Morrell for medical expenses. Ann Wilkins seconded the motion, unanimously passed.

Mayor Reid announced that sealed bids would be received in the mayor's office at the temporary location of Red Bay City Hall, 513 1<sup>st</sup> Street S.E., Red Bay, AL, until 12:00 noon, March 28, 2007 on the following:

1. Used dozer
2. Financing of a used dozer
3. Tractor
4. Rewiring the electrical system at Bay Tree Park

Mayor Reid announced that the next regular scheduled council meeting will be held on Monday, April 2, 2007, 7:00 p.m. Red Bay Senior Citizen Building.

Pat Hammock made a motion to approve the bills, seconded by Rayford Seahorn, unanimously passed.

Ann Wilkins made a motion to approve the minutes of the last regular meeting held March 5, 2007, seconded by Pat Hammock, unanimously passed.
