**MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL
July 2, 2007**

The City Council of Red Bay met in a regular meeting on Monday July 2, 2007 at 7:00 p.m. The meeting was held in the Red Bay Senior Citizens Building, 115 5th Ave SE, Red Bay, AL 35582.

Present and presiding was Mayor Jeff Reid. Council Members present were Rayford Seahorn, Ann Wilkins and Ricky Holland.

Council Members absent: Bobby Nelson and Pat Hammock.

Linda B. Holcomb, City Clerk, was present and recording.

Also present were Fire Chief Bud Strickland, Police Chief Pat Creel, City Auditor Dicky Sparks CPA, and John Benn.

Police Chief Pat Creel led the Invocation.

Fire Chief Bud Strickland led the Allegiance to the Flag.

Rayford Seahorn made a motion to allow Police Chief Pat Creel to attend the following two conferences:

- (1) August 21-24, 2007 State Association of Chiefs of Police, Auburn, AL
- (2) October 13-17, 2007 International Association of Chiefs of Police, New Orleans, LA

Ricky Holland seconded the motion, unanimously passed.

John Benn addressed the Council concerning the website located at www.redbay.info, beginning in August the website hosting group will charge a monthly fee of seventy-five dollars. The City will need to pay the fee or secure web hosting through another service. Mr. Benn has maintained the site and posted council agendas and approved minutes for approximately two years. Mayor Reid stated that he would check into the matter and contact Mr. Benn at a later date. Mayor Reid thanked Mr. Benn for his service to the City.

City Auditor Dicky Sparks CPA presented the 2005-2006 Audit. Attachment **A**

Mayor Jeff Reid presented for adoption and read Ordinance #07-06-04A, a burn ordinance, in its entirety. Rayford Seahorn made a motion to adopt the ordinance, seconded by Ann Wilkins, unanimously passed.

Mayor Jeff Reid introduced Ordinance #07-07-02 an ordinance amending Ordinance #05-09-19A, a flood plain prevention ordinance. The ordinance will be presented at the next regular scheduled meeting for adoption.

Ricky Holland made a motion to table approving names for designating the sections of the City of Red Bay Cemetery until all council members were present. The motion was seconded by Rayford Seahorn, unanimously passed.

Ricky Holland made a motion to purchase rock at a cost of between \$4,500.00 and \$5,500.00, to construct 7th Street NW. Ann Wilkins seconded the motion, unanimously passed.

Mayor Jeff Reid made the following announcements:

1. The next regular scheduled council meeting will be Monday, July 16, 2007, 7:00 p.m., in the new Red Bay City Hall, located at 203 4th Ave S.E.
2. The City is receiving sealed bids on a 2000 Chevrolet Impala (used police car) in the Mayor's Office until 12:00 noon, Friday July 13, 2007. The vehicle can be viewed in the public Parking lot located at 115 5th Ave S.E.
3. Red Bay Water and Gas Board unexpired term of Joe Beasley. An appointment will be made At the August 6, 2007 council meeting. Deadline for interested persons to sign the list at city hall is Wednesday, 12:00 noon, August 1, 2007.


Ricky Holland made a motion to approve the bills, seconded by Ann Wilkins, unanimously passed.

Ricky Holland made a motion to approve the minutes of the last regular meeting held June 18, 2007, seconded by Ann Wilkins. Unanimously passed.


