Due to a dispute on the bid award for the sewer solvent at the last council meeting, Ricky Holland made a motion to table making another decision until sewage employee Dennie Robinson has time to review the bids and make a recommendation to the council. The motion was seconded by Pat Hammock, unanimously passed.

Mayor Reid gave the Council a sample bill board ordinance.

Ricky Holland made a motion to take bids on a new police vehicle. Motion died for lack of a second.

Bobby Nelson made a motion to support the 07-08 NACOLG program by issuing a check in the amount of \$7363.42 (seven thousand three hundred and sixty-three dollars forty-two cents), this covers the appropriation dues, transit program, and area agency on aging program. Ann Wilkins seconded the motion, unanimously passed.

Ann Wilkins made a motion to support the Alabama Public Library Service Grant if awarded to the Weatherford Library. The grant application was filed for \$50,000.00 (fifty-thousand dollars), if awarded the city's match will be thirty percent. Grant funds will be used to renovate the building. Bobby Nelson seconded the motion, unanimously passed.

Due to vandalism at the water park and Hoyt Keeton Walking Trail, Pat Hammock made a motion to fence portions of the area, seconded by Ann Wilkins, unanimously passed.

Pat Hammock made a motion to stripe the newly paved portion of 4<sup>th</sup> Street W., also known as Golden Road, when the paving crew is in town, seconded by Bobby Nelson, unanimously passed.

Bobby Nelson made a motion to table hiring an employee with a CDL License to drive the truck which runs the garbage alley route until present employees were asked to take the CDL test. Ann Wilkins seconded the motion, unanimously passed.

Pat Hammock made a motion to take bids for a dump bed for the 1999 GMC Truck. A deadline for accepting the bids will be set at a later date. Ann Wilkins seconded the motion, unanimously passed.

Ann Wilkins made a motion to adopt Resolution #07-11-19, seconded by Pat Hammock, unanimously passed. Attachment A


