**MINUTES OF A REGULAR SCHEDULED MEETING**  
**RED BAY CITY COUNCIL**  
**September 2, 2008**

The City Council of Red Bay met in a regular scheduled meeting September 2, 2008, 7:00 p.m. The meeting was held in the Red Bay City Hall Council Room, 203 4<sup>th</sup> Ave. S.E., Red Bay, AL.

Present and presiding was Mayor Jeff Reid. Council members present were Bobby Nelson, David Martin, Pat Hammock, Ann Wilkins and Ricky Holland.

Linda B. Holcomb, City Clerk, was present and recording.

Also present were Police Chief Pat Creel, Fire Chief Bud Strickland and City Supervisor Wayne Sims.

David Martin led the Invocation.

Bobby Nelson led the Allegiance to the Flag.

Yellow Book Representative Carl Bradberry was not present to address the Council. Pat Hammock made a motion to purchase a listing in the Yellow Pages Phone Directory for the Red Bay Water Park. Ann Wilkins seconded the motion, unanimously passed.

Fire Chief Bud Strickland notified the Council that he had received two checks to be deposited in the fire fund. The first was in the amount of \$1922.60 (one thousand nine hundred twenty two dollars and sixty cents) from the Alabama Forestry Commission. The second was in the amount of three hundred eighty-two dollars and seventy-four cents (\$382.74) from the State of Alabama Tobacco Tax Fund. He stated that the Fire Department was in need of seven fire pages which would cost approximately three thousand two hundred dollars. Ricky Holland made a motion to purchase the fire pages and to transfer the extra funds needed from the general fund. Bobby Nelson seconded the motion, unanimously passed.

Bobby Nelson made a motion to approve the 2008-2009 NACOLG Senior Aide Program Budget request in the amount of five thousand two hundred and fifty dollars (\$5,250.00). Ann Wilkins seconded the motion, unanimously passed. The amount approved will fund seven senior aides at a cost of seven hundred and fifty dollars (\$750.00) each.

Ann Wilkins made a motion to pave needed areas on 7<sup>th</sup> Avenue and the entrance areas for the two Safe-T-Shelters. Ricky Holland seconded the motion, unanimously passed. J.A. Sykes Drive in the Red Bay City Cemetery will also be paved due to prior approval by the Council on June 2, 2008.

Mayor Jeff Reid made the following announcement; the next regular scheduled council meeting will be Monday, September 15, 2008, 7:00 p.m. The meeting will be held in the Red Bay City Hall Council Room, 203 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue S.E., Red Bay, AL 35582.

Ann Wilkins made a motion to approve the bills for payment, seconded by Ricky Holland, unanimously passed.

Ann Wilkins made a motion to approve the workshop minutes and the council minutes for August 18, 2008, David Martin seconded the motion, voting **For** were David Martin, Pat Hammock, Ann Wilkins, and Ricky Holland. Bobby Nelson **abstained** due to being absent at the meeting.

Bobby Nelson made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Ricky Holland, unanimously passed.
