**MINUTES OF A REGULAR SCHEDULED MEETING**  
**RED BAY CITY COUNCIL**  
**October 6, 2008**

The City Council of Red Bay met in a regular scheduled meeting October 6, 2008, 7:00 p.m. The meeting was held in the Red Bay City Hall Council Room, 203 4<sup>th</sup> Ave. S.E., Red Bay, AL

Present and presiding was Mayor Jeff Reid. Council members present were Bobby Nelson, David Martin, Pat Hammock, Ann Wilkins and Ricky Holland.

Linda B. Holcomb, City Clerk, was present and recording.

Also present were Police Chief Pat Creel, Fire Chief Bud Strickland, City Supervisor Wayne Sims, Rhonda Beam, Judy Bullen and Charlene Fancher.

Bobby Nelson led the Invocation.

David Martin led the Allegiance to the Flag.

Charlene Fancher addressed the Council concerning Governor Bob Riley's statewide promotion "The Year of Alabama Small Towns & Downtowns". Pat Hammock made a motion to appoint Rosalyn Fabianke as chairperson for the Red Bay Committee to support the event. Ann Wilkins seconded the motion, unanimously passed. Charlene Fancher read Resolution #08-10-06 in its entirety, a resolution declaring the third weekend of September 2010 as Red Bay's homecoming weekend, which will coincide with the annual Founders Fest. Bobby Nelson made a motion to adopt the resolution, seconded by Pat Hammock, unanimously passed. **Attachment A**

Rhonda Beam, chairperson for the City of Red Bay Education Committee, addressed the Council and thanked them for the sixty-five thousand dollars (\$65,000.00) that they had appropriated from the Occupational Tax Fund to the Education Fund for the 08-09 year. She also gave a report on past expenditures for the committee.

Police Chief Pat Creel reported to the Council that the Bureau of Justice Grant has been approved in the amount of seventeen thousand eight hundred and eighty-seven dollars (\$17,887.00). He informed the Council that the cost of a drug-sniffing dog, training for the dog, bullet proof blankets, and accessories will be covered by the grant.

Pat Hammock made a motion to appoint Ron Harris to a six-year term on the Senior Citizen Board. The term will expire October 1, 2014. Ann Wilkins seconded the motion, unanimously passed.

Pat Hammock made a motion to renew the monthly contribution of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) to the Franklin County Development Authority for the 2008-2009 year. Ricky Holland seconded the motion, unanimously passed.

Ricky Holland made a motion to renew the contract with the Franklin County Chamber of Commerce for the 2008-2009 year and to pay the annual fee of three thousand five hundred dollars (\$3,500.00) in four quarterly installments of eight hundred and seventy-five dollars (\$875.00). Pat Hammock seconded the motion, unanimously passed.

Ricky Holland made a motion to take bids on a metal roof for the Senior Citizen Building located at 115 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue. Bobby Nelson seconded the motion, unanimously passed.

Ricky Holland made a motion to purchase three pool covers for the Red Bay Water Park at a cost of twelve thousand five hundred and fifty-four dollars (\$12,554.00). Pat Hammock seconded the motion, unanimously passed. The covers will be used to cover the main pool, the adult pool and the slide pool.

Pat Hammock made a motion to honor the request of local churches to observe Halloween in the city limits of Red Bay on Saturday night, November 1, 2008. Bobby Nelson seconded the motion, unanimously passed.

David Martin made a motion to table a request from 1<sup>st</sup> Baptist Church to close a portion of 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue during their Sunday services and Wednesday night service. Pat Hammock seconded the motion, unanimously passed.

Mayor Jeff Reid made the following announcements:

1. A Called meeting of the Red Bay City Council will be held at 11:45 a.m., Tuesday, October 14, 2008. The purpose of the meeting will be to canvass the election held on October 7, 2008. The meeting will be held at the Red Bay City Hall Council Room, located at 203 4<sup>th</sup> Ave S.E., Red Bay, AL
2. The next regular scheduled council meeting will be held on Monday, October 20, 2008, 7:00 p.m. Red Bay City Hall, 203 4<sup>th</sup> Ave S.E., Red Bay, AL


Ricky Holland made a motion to approve the bills, seconded by David Martin, unanimously passed.
