**MINUTES OF A REGULAR SCHEDULED MEETING**  
**RED BAY CITY COUNCIL**  
**October 20, 2008**

The City Council of Red Bay met in a regular scheduled meeting October 20, 2008, 7:00 p.m. The meeting was held in the Red Bay City Hall Council Room, 203 4<sup>th</sup> Ave. S.E., Red Bay, AL

Present and presiding was Mayor Jeff Reid. Council members present were Bobby Nelson, David Martin, Pat Hammock, Ann Wilkins and Ricky Holland.

Also present were Police Sergeant Scotty Chandler and City Supervisor Wayne Sims.

Police Chief Pat Creel and Fire Chief Bud Strickland were absent due to attending federal grant meetings.

Linda B. Holcomb, City Clerk, was present and recording.

Ricky Holland led the Invocation.

Ann Wilkins led the Allegiance to the Flag.

Four bids were submitted to roof the senior citizen building. L & J Construction, Red Bay, AL submitted three bids. Gary Credille, Belmont, MS submitted one bid. Bobby Nelson made a motion to accept a bid from L & J Construction for \$17,642.00 (seventeen thousand six hundred and forty-two dollars). The bid was for a metal snap-lock roof and removal of the old roof. Ricky Holland seconded the motion. Voting **for** were Bobby Nelson, David Martin, Ann Wilkins, and Ricky Holland. Pat Hammock **abstained**.

Bobby Nelson made a motion to give all full-time employees a fifty cent per hour cost of living raise, seconded by David Martin, unanimously passed.

Effective as of October 1, 2008 the State of Alabama imposed a one dollar per ton charge on everything placed in landfills. Pat Hammock made a motion to raise the fees by one dollar per ton at the Red Bay Landfill to cover the tax. Ricky Holland seconded the motion, unanimously passed.

Bobby Nelson made a motion to grant a request made by the Red Bay Varsity Football Team to hold a roadblock on November 15, 2008 to raise funds for a trip to Florida. Pat Hammock seconded the motion, unanimously passed.

Mayor Jeff Reid made the following announcements:

1. The next regular scheduled council meeting will be held on Monday, November 3, 2008, 7:00 p.m. Red Bay City Hall, 203 4<sup>th</sup> Ave S.E., Red Bay, AL
2. Industrial Development Board – two vacant positions:  
Brad M. Bolton's six-year term expiring December 1, 2008  
David Tiffin's six-year term expiring December 1, 2009

Requirements for the position are: must live within the city limits and can not be an officer or an employee of the city. Mr. Bolton and Mr. Tiffin are to take office as council members on November 3, 2008 and will no longer be eligible to serve on the Industrial Development Board.

Pat Hammock made a motion to approve the bills, seconded by David Martin, unanimously passed.

Ann Wilkins made a motion to approve the workshop minutes and council minutes for October 6, 2008. Pat Hammock seconded the motion, unanimously passed.

Pat Hammock made a motion to approve the minutes for a called meeting held on October 14, 2008, seconded by Ann Wilkins. Voting for approval were David Martin, Pat Hammock, and Ann Wilkins. Abstaining were Bobby Nelson and Ricky Holland due to being absent at the meeting.

Bobby Nelson made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Pat Hammock, unanimously passed.
