**MINUTES OF A REGULAR SCHEDULED MEETING**  
**RED BAY CITY COUNCIL**  
**March 2, 2009**

The City Council of Red Bay met in a regular scheduled meeting March 2, 2009, 7:00 p.m. The meeting was held in the Red Bay City Hall Council Room, 203 4<sup>th</sup> Ave. S.E., Red Bay, AL

Present and presiding was Mayor Bobby Forsythe. Council members present were Mike Kennedy, Mike Stockton, David Tiffin, Charlene Fancher, and Brad M. Bolton.

Also present were City Attorney Senator Roger Bedford, Police Chief Pat Creel, and Street and Sanitation Supervisor Wayne Sims. Fire Chief Bud Strickland was absent due to attending a grant seminar.

Police Sergeant Scottie Belue was present and acting in the position of Sergeant at Arms.

Linda B. Holcomb, City Clerk, was present and recording.

Mike Kennedy led the Invocation.

Mike Stockton led the Allegiance to the Flag.

Mayor Bobby Forsythe recommended that David Tiffin, Charlene Fancher, and Chief Pat Creel schedule a time to review all applications submitted for the position of police patrol officer. Mayor Forsythe then stated that the City of Red Bay is an Equal Opportunity Employer.

Brad M. Bolton made a motion to send Mayor Forsythe to the Alabama League of Municipalities Annual Business Convention as the voting delegate for the City. David Tiffin seconded the motion, unanimously passed. Mike Kennedy made a motion to send David Tiffin as first alternate. Mike Stockton seconded the motion, voting **for** were Mike Kennedy, Mike Stockton, Charlene Fancher, and Brad M. Bolton. David Tiffin **abstained**. The convention will be held May 2 through May 5, 2009 in Montgomery.

Brad M. Bolton presented the proposed employee handbook. Two copies will be placed at city hall for employees to review. If an employee has a concern with items in the handbook or not in the handbook that person will need to contact the Mayor or a Councilmember before the next regular scheduled council meeting.

Mayor Bobby Forsythe called for a motion to approve the minutes of the last regular scheduled council meeting due to the motion and second contained therein to purchase

two new police vehicles from Page Chevrolet. Mike Stockton made the motion, Mike Kennedy seconded the motion, unanimously passed.

Brad M. Bolton made a motion to pay twenty percent down on the cost of two new police vehicles to be purchased from Page Chevrolet, Red Bay. Mike Stockton seconded the motion, unanimously passed.

Charlene Fancher made a motion to accept bids from all local lending institutions for financing of the two new police vehicles. Mike Kennedy seconded the motion, unanimously passed.

David Tiffin made a motion to open the bids for financing at the next regular scheduled council meeting. The motion was seconded by Charlene Fancher, unanimously passed.

Mayor Bobby Forsythe presented the bids received by the Sewage Disposal Board on February 25 for the purchase of aerators to be installed at the lagoon. Three bids were received:

1. Prime Line, Inc., Scooba, MS \$21,950.00
2. S & N Airoflo, Birmingham, AL \$23,344.00
3. Stillwater Machine, LLC, Newbern, AL \$21,780.00

Charlene Fancher made a motion to accept the lowest bid of twenty-one thousand seven hundred and eighty dollars submitted by Stillwater Machine, LLC, Newbern, AL. Brad M. Bolton seconded the motion, unanimously passed.

Mike Stockton made a motion to approve the bills for payment, seconded by Mike Kennedy. Voting **for** were Mike Kennedy, Mike Stockton and Charlene Fancher. David Tiffin **abstained** from voting to approve the bills submitted by Tiffin Supply and City Auto Parts but voted to approve all other bills. Brad M. Bolton **abstained** from voting to approve payments to Community Spirit Bank but voted to approve all other bills.

Charlene Fancher made a motion to approve the workshop minutes and council minutes for the regular scheduled meeting held February 16, 2009. Mike Stockton seconded the motion. Voting **for** were Mike Kennedy, Mike Stockton, Charlene Fancher, and Brad M. Bolton. David Tiffin **abstained**.

Mayor Bobby Forsythe made the following announcements:



- The City of Red Bay and Red Bay Water and Gas are accepting fuel bids until 4:00 p.m., March 11, 2009


