**CITY OF RED BAY**

**MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING  
RED BAY CITY COUNCIL  
September 20, 2010  
7:00 p.m.**

The City Council of Red Bay met in a regular scheduled meeting September 20, 2010 in the Red Bay City Hall Council Room, 203 4<sup>th</sup> Ave. S.E., Red Bay, AL. The meeting convened at 7:10 p.m.

Present and presiding was Mayor Bobby Forsythe.

Council Members present were Mike Kennedy, Mike Stockton, David Tiffin, Charlene Fancher, and Brad M. Bolton.

Also present were City Attorney Senator Roger Bedford, Police Chief Janna Jackson, Park and Recreation Director Joey Allen, Street and Sanitation Supervisor Wayne Sims, Fire Chief Bud Strickland, Water and Gas Superintendent Joe Beasley, and Rosalyn Fabianke.

Captain Eddie Chandler was present and acting as Sergeant at Arms.

Linda B. Holcomb, City Clerk, was present and recording.

David Tiffin led the Invocation.

Mike Kennedy led the Allegiance to the Flag.

Mayor Bobby Forsythe recognized Rosalyn Fabianke for her appointment to the Governor's Physical Fitness Commission. Mrs. Fabianke addressed the Council explaining details of the appointment and functions of the Commission.

David Tiffin made a motion to amend the agenda to allow Water and Gas Superintendent Joe Beasley to address the Council. Brad M. Bolton seconded the motion. The roll call vote was as follows: Mike Kennedy "yeas", Mike Stockton "yeas", David Tiffin "yeas", Charlene Fancher "yeas", and Brad M. Bolton "yeas".

Mr. Beasley addressed the Council concerning a recent newscast where he spoke on television addressing the fact that Red Bay Water and Gas no longer adds fluoride to the water. Mr. Beasley added that the Red Bay Water System is in the top thirty for the State of Alabama according to Alabama Department of Environmental Management.

Park and Recreation Director Joey Allen addressed the Council with the following two items:

- The Red Bay Water Park had a profitable 2010 season but is in need of pool repairs.
- The Park and Recreation Board Members are working to develop a system to monitor inappropriate behavior at games and events to protect those attending.

Charlene Fancher made a motion to accept applications for the position of part-time police dispatcher for a period of two weeks. Mike Stockton seconded the motion, unanimously passed.

Charlene Fancher made a motion to approve applying for a HRAB Grant to preserve and store city maps with a fifty percent match up to three thousand dollars. Brad M. Bolton seconded the motion, unanimously passed.

Mayor Bobby Forsythe made a motion to table amending the 2009-2010 Budget. Mike Stockton seconded the motion, unanimously passed.

Mike Stockton made a motion to table discussing employee health insurance coverage. Mike Kennedy seconded the motion, unanimously passed.

Brad M. Bolton made a motion to promote Joey Allen from probationary status to a permanent, fulltime, at-will employee. Charlene Fancher seconded the motion, unanimously passed.

Charlene Fancher made a motion to appoint Donna Weatherford to fill Donnie Hastings position on the Park and Recreation Board. This is a three-year term expiring March 18, 2011. Mike Kennedy seconded the motion, unanimously passed.

Brad M. Bolton made a motion to allow the Red Bay Youth Cheerleaders to hold a November 6, 2010 roadblock. Mike Stockton seconded the motion. Voting **for** were Mike Kennedy, Mike Stockton, Charlene Fancher, and Brad M. Bolton. David Tiffin **abstained**.

David Tiffin made a motion to set the annual Halloween Trick or Treat Night for Red Bay 2010 on Saturday, October 30. Mike Kennedy seconded the motion, unanimously passed.




David Tiffin made a motion to approve minutes for a workshop and council meeting held September 7, 2010. Mike Stockton seconded the motion, unanimously passed.
